**“Vaping and Beyond: Current Adolescent Drug Trends and Terms,
What Parents & Teens Need to Know”
presented by Matt Quinn, MA, LCPS, CADC**

Matt Quinn provides community relations in the western suburbs of Chicago in DuPage, Kane, and Kendall counties. He is a member of the Community Alliance for Prevention in Naperville, The Juvenile Justice Council in Kane County, and a consultant for the Connect for Life program through the Naperville Police Department. Quinn joined Rosecrance as an outreach counselor in 2015. He led the Parent Cafe support group, conducted regular prevention and early intervention classes, and conducted substance use assessments in the Naperville office. With a BS degree in psychology from Notre Dame and a master's degree in clinical psychology from the Illinois School of Professional Psychology, Quinn is a Licensed Clinical Professional Counselor and Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor in Illinois. He was the program coordinator for the adolescent intensive outpatient program at Linden Oaks at Elmhurst for 8 years prior to coming to Rosecrance.
